They also learnt about Table manners and opposites on Big and Small.

#### **JRKG**

The Concept for Jr.Kg was about the Water Kingdom. The children learnt about Sources, Forms and Uses of Water. They also learnt about the Sea animals and the important measures to Save Water. The moral value of the month was Helping Others. The state of the month was Gujarat and the Achiever of the month was Lata Mangeshkar.



#### **NURSERY**

The Concept for Nursery for the month of September was All About the Sea animals. They learnt topics like different sources of Water and the Water cycle. They enjoyed learning about the characteristics of Sea animals, shells, pearls and corals. They were introduced to Curved lines this month. They met letters V, X and K from the letter land. AY CARE



The Topic for the Day care was Environment and Us. Children learnt about the Environment and its components, Weather and Seasons and formation of Day and night. They also learnt on how to keep the environment clean. They enjoyed hands-on activities related to the concept.

- Be Nurturing: The most important thing in your child's life is Motivation. If you believe in your child and motivate them at every step of the way, they learn to believe in themselves. Avoid Sarcasm and Criticism. Be mindful of how you communicate your point to them even in the worst case scenario.
- 2) Mind your Language: Be very careful about what you speak and how you speak to your children and also to others. Using the right words, avoiding cuss words and using the right tone of your voice are some of the things you must take care.
- 3) Behaviour: It is rightly said that the best parents lead by example. Therefore be at your best behaviour in front of your children. Your behaviour should be the same that you expect from your children.

- 4) Ethics and Principles: If you lie in front of your children indirectly you are telling them "It is OK to lie" Simply saying how your child should be is not enough. Walk the talk. Always tell the truth, be polite, say thank you and sorry whenever it should be said, be kind to people even your house-help, a waiter, your driver etc. Teach your children the values of life by living it yourself.
- 5) Be Grounded: Your children need to understand what is more important in life. Materialistic things or things that really matter in life like happiness, relationships, friends and family. Make them realise what matters most in life.

If you want to raise a good person and a good human being, be the example your children will follow. After all, Our parents are our first Super heroes and Role models.
